## VILLAGE HALL OF HARRISTOWN August 24, 2020

The Village of Harristown Board of Trustees held their monthly meeting on August 24, 2020 at 185 N. Kembark. Trustee Les Jenkins, Larry Ditty, Kevin Vessels, Teresa Acree, Becky Nave, Cody Endrizzi, Treasurer Rose, Budget Officer Laskowski, Attorney Drew Weatherford, Clerk Allen and Mayor Deverell was present. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

# Consent agenda/minutes

Motion by Trustee Vessels to adopt the consent agenda. Endrizzi 2<sup>nd</sup>. Approved 6-0. Motion by Trustee Endrizzi to approve minutes from July 27, 2020. Jenkins 2<sup>nd</sup>. Approved 6-0.

### **Visitors**

Brandon Barick-ACTLLC- tabled

Aubie Endrizzi-he is buying John Durflingers property. Waiting to see what the Board decides about this property.

Kevin Buckley- from McGuire, Yuhas, Huffman and Buckley (auditors) discussed the audit report. Next year, with the IEPA load, will keep the audit the same but break out the water and sewer and do those accounts as accurals. The Mayor requested the Board to look at the audit reports.

Trustee Endrizzi requested the Zoning committee report be move up so the visitors could leave.

## Zoning Committee

A certificate of occupancy is needed for the new building for the insurance company. Mayor Deverell gave a copy to Attorney Weatherford.

Durflinger Jeremy Phillips indicated a hearing was not held but everything else is done. Durflinger put 4 plats together. Mr. Endrizzi would like to buy part of it now; split into 2 lots. An on site hearing is needed to be held but this step was skipped. Two options: do as ordinance states or option 2, skip the hearing. Mr. Phillips questioned if Macon Street was actually built to have house/traffic on it and a driveway for a house. If a hearing is held, this could be discussed. Should the road be wider, chipped? Any road damage would be the village's problem and cost. Motion by Trustee Acree to accept the minor subdivision of Durflinger's property on Macon Street and make it 2 lots. Vessels 2<sup>nd</sup>. Roll call: Acree,yes; Nave, yes; Ditty, yes, Vessels, yes, Endrizzi, abstain; Jenkins, abstain. Approved 4-2.

#### Mayor Updates

New Village Hall- per the health department, the kitchen does not have to be inspected because it is not commercial. Cleaning Person has been hired. Most furniture is ordered. Chief Gambrill stating the new building could hold 200 people. Mayor will get something in writing from him

Water rates-water rate increase 3% on September 1. Minimum charge and sewer rates stay the same.

Water Improvement/tower-Ron Legner said the notice of awards and contract documents have been sent to the 2 low bidders. Received the signed contract documents back from Caldwell Tanks, but still waiting for Burdickto send theirs back. Once contracts are back, will issue a notice to proceed to each contractor and get their proposed construction schedules.

Parks Brothers-West Main Street Sewer and Water Main extensions-water main and sewer are installed and both have passed required testing. Plan to complete the final grading and seeding in next couple weeks. They have submitted their first payment request. Pat O Dell will need to complete a form as the current licensed operator to get the final operating permit from IEPA. Motion by Trustee Vessels to pay from TIF fund to Petersburg Plumbing, \$82,873.25. Jenkins 2<sup>nd</sup>. Roll call: Vessels, yes; Acree, yes; Ditty, yes; Endrizzi, yes; Jenkins, yes; Nave, yes. Approved 6-0..

2021 MFT Project-No MFT this year. Mayor requested Board members to look at areas in the village and give suggestions on what may need to be done.

*Pond-Partridge Trace*-this is causing drainage issues. Mayor will give Ron info on previous studies done.

**Public Works-**EJ Water Cooperative will hopefully have the issues at the water plant figured out soon.
