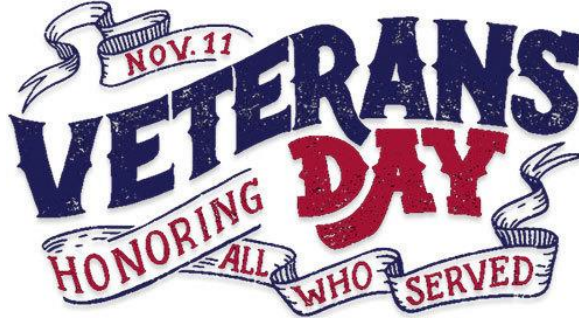

Don't burn if the yard waste is wet, it can create visibility hazards and can affect residents with breathing issues. **ONLY YARD WASTE** may be burned.



## Brush Collection will be November 14th

Remember **All** yard waste needs to be in **Bags**. All branches need to be cut into 4 foot or less lengths. Brush pick-up is intended for branches removed during routine trimming or due to storm damage. **This will be the last pickup before winter.**
